

Some Facts about the INKY SAR Conference

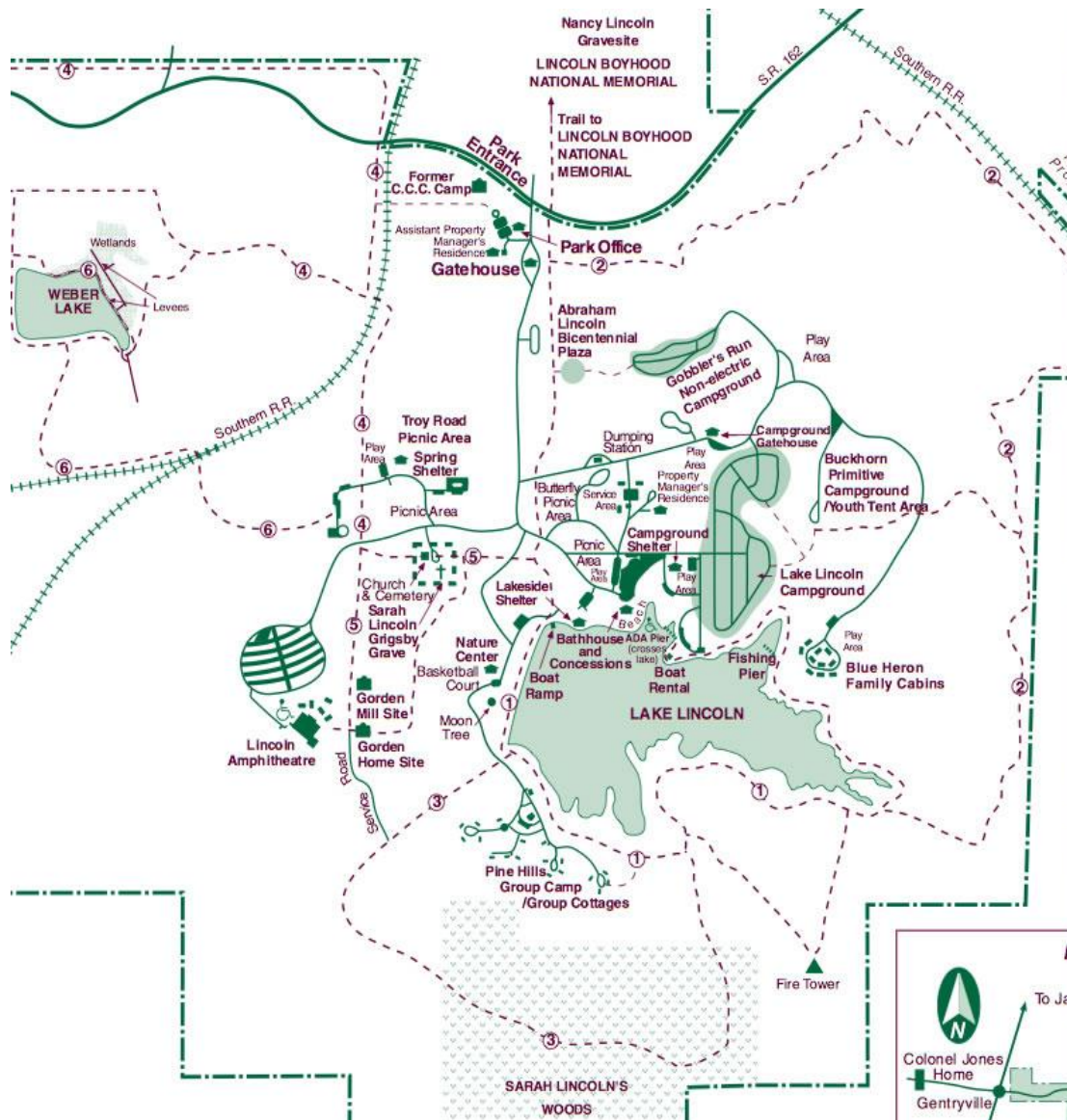

1. Meals will be provided, if you are on a special diet, please bring your own provisions.
2. The Pine Hills Group Camp Area consists of Non-heated cabins with bunk or single beds. Please bring your own bedding.
3. There is a daily sign in sheet. If you leave, please sign out and tell someone **at** the Command Center.
4. Be sure to check in if you are *not* staying at Pine Hills Group site. Example: Hotel or other camp facility at the park.
5. There will be **no alcohol** or firearms allowed on the premises during the weekend training.
6. No ATV's will be permitted in the park.
7. Conference age limit is 18.
8. A release of liability form **must** be completed by anyone before participating in any training activities.
9. All personal attending the outdoor exercises will need appropriate clothing and safety equipment during training, (Flashlight with extra batteries, boots, long sleeve shirt, long pants, water, etc).
10. All dogs attending must have proof of appropriate vaccinations.
11. A veterinarian will be on call during weekend exercises.
12. You will need to provide food and kennel for your dog.
13. **All dogs will be kenneled or on leash except when working on a training exercise. They are not permitted in the buildings.**
14. **Aggressive behavior will result in termination of training.**
